GENERAL RAIL SAFETY

REMOVING YOUR HEADPHONES OR TURNING THE MUSIC DOWN WHEN YOU'RE NEAR **RAILROAD TRACKS**

LOUD MUSIC OR DISTRACTING SOUNDS CAN DROWN OUT THE IMPORTANT NOISES AROUND YOU, INCLUDING THE SOUND OF AN APPROACHING TRAIN. TRAINS CAN BE QUIET AND HARD TO HEAR UNTIL IT'S TOO LATE. BY STAYING AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS, YOU CAN BETTER AVOID DANGEROUS SITUATIONS AND ENSURE YOUR SAFETY.

OBEY RAILROAD RIGNS, SIGNALS AND LIGHTS

THEY ARE IN PLACE FOR YOUR SAFETY. THESE WARNINGS PROVIDE IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TRAIN MOVEMENTS AND POTENTIAL DANGER. IGNORING THEM CAN PUT YOUR LIFE AND OTHERS' LIVES AT RISK. NEVER TAKE CHANCES WHEN IT COMES TO RAILROAD SAFETY, REMEMBER. THESE MEASURES EXIST TO PROTECT YOU AND PREVENT ACCIDENTS.

STOP, LOOK AND LISTEN FOR TRAINS

WHETHER YOU'RE WALKING OR CYCLING, IT'S CRUCIAL TO ALWAYS STOP, LOOK BOTH WAYS, AND LISTEN CAREFULLY FOR THE SOUND OF APPROACHING TRAINS, TAKING THESE SIMPLE PRECAUTIONS CAN HELP ENSURE YOUR SAFETY NEAR RAILROAD TRACKS.

KEEP OFF RAILWAY TRACKS, YARDS, TUNNELS AND BRIDGES

THESE ARE DANGEROUS AREAS AND SHOULD NEVER BE ENTERED. ALWAYS REMEMBER, YOUR SAFETY IS IMPORTANT. DON'T TRESPASS ON RAILROAD PROPERTY - IT'S ILLEGAL AND CAN BE DEADLY. STAY SAFE, AND RESPECT THE WARNING SIGNS.

NEVER TRY TO RACE A TRAIN

TRAINS ARE MUCH FASTER THAN THEY APPEAR. AND THEIR SPEED CAN CATCH YOU OFF GUARD. EVEN IF A TRAIN SEEMS FAR AWAY, IT CAN CLOSE THE DISTANCE IN SECONDS. ALWAYS REMEMBER THAT TRAINS CAN'T STOP QUICKLY, AND TRYING TO BEAT ONE TO A CROSSING IS EXTREMELY DANGEROUS, YOUR SAFETY IS FAR MORE IMPORTANT THAN ANY TIME SAVED, SO ALWAYS WAIT FOR THE TRAIN TO PASS.

ONLY CROSS AT MARKED CROSSINGS

ALWAYS CROSS RAILROAD TRACKS ONLY AT DESIGNATED, MARKED CROSSINGS. TAKING A SHORTCUT MIGHT SEEM TEMPTING, BUT IT'S NEVER WORTH THE RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY OR EVEN DEATH. RAILROADS CAN BE UNPREDICTABLE, AND TRAIN MOVEMENTS ARE FAST AND OFTEN QUIET. YOUR SAFETY SHOULD ALWAYS COME FIRST -NEVER RISK YOUR LIFE TO SAVE A FEW SECONDS.
