




Staying Sharp: Rail Safety Week Sept 15–21, 2025

Each year, Rail Safety Week unites communities, organizations, and families across Canada to raise awareness about the importance of being vigilant and responsible around railroad tracks. In 2025, this vital observance will run from September 15 to 21.

Tragically, in 2024 there were 258 crossing and trespassing incidents in Canada, resulting in 80 preventable fatalities. These statistics underscore why awareness and education remain essential. Railways are not play areas, and even a momentary lapse in attention can have lasting and devastating consequences.

Key safety reminders for everyone:

- Always stop a safe distance from railway crossings.
- Look both ways and listen carefully before crossing tracks.
- Obey all signs and signals.
- Speak up and act if you witness unsafe behavior near tracks.

Rail Safety Week is about communities stepping up. Whether you're a driver, pedestrian, parent, or employer, you can help stop tragedies before they happen.
