




Total fatalities in 2025

SUNDAY

is the day when most incidents occur. 18% of incidents this year have happened on a Sunday.



- Alberta leads the country with the highest crossing incident rate: 7.6 incidents per 1,000 crossings.
- Manitoba (6.9) and British Columbia (6.2) also show elevated rates compared to the national average.
- Ontario, despite having nearly as many crossings as Saskatchewan, records a higher incident rate (5.9 vs. 2.0 per 1,000).
- Saskatchewan has the lowest rate (2.0 per 1,000).
