This Family Day, let's give our families the best gift of all – a safe return home.

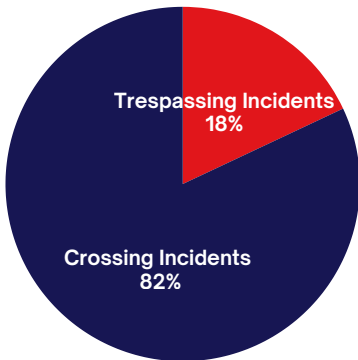

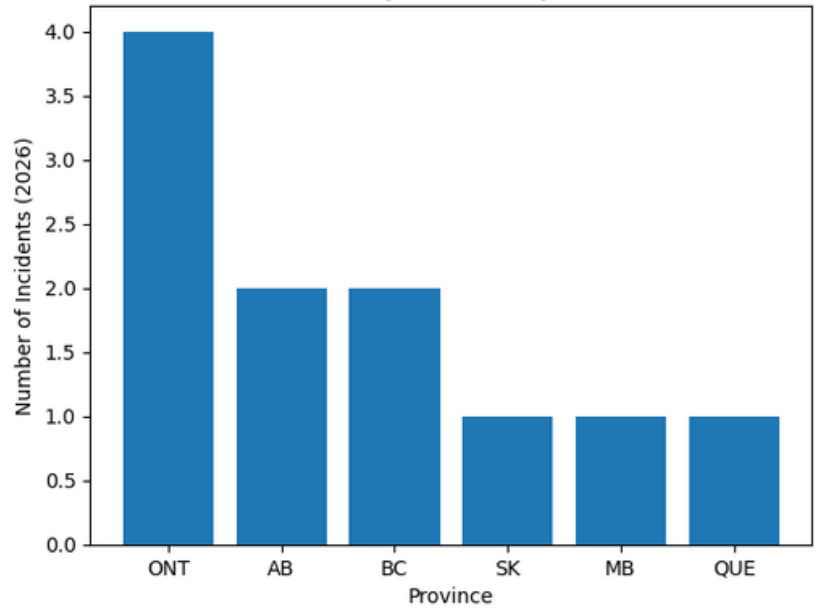
